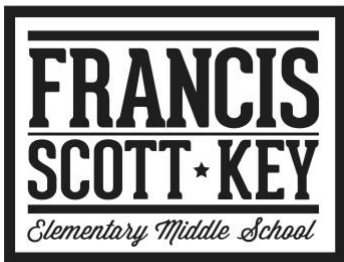


## 22-23 FSK Uniform Policy and Procedures

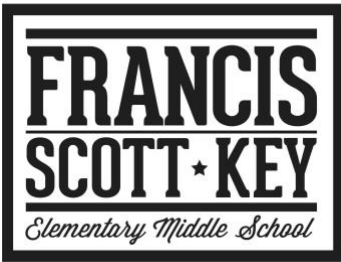

**Student Appearance**

- Students will be expected to be in uniform, well-groomed, and neatly dressed at all times.
- Any form of dress which is considered contrary to good hygiene or which is distracting or disruptive in appearance and detrimental to the purpose of conduct of the school will not be permitted.
- Short shorts, tube tops, halters, sweat pants or other similar items of clothing will not be permitted on boys or girls
- Thong sandals, sports slides, or flip-flops are not permitted
- Shirts advertising alcoholic beverages/drugs or with obscene or questionable printing on shirts will not be permitted
- Shorts and Skirts must be close to the knee and appropriate
- Students should not have their midriff exposed

**Procedures for Students Out of Uniform:**



Students that come to school out of uniform will be directed to Mr. Harrison in room 204 each morning. Mr. Harrison will do the following:

1. Provide the student with a uniform (If it is an on-going issue, parents will be contacted and incentives will be lost)
2. Each student will sign-out the uniform and will be responsible for handing it back to Mr. Harrison at 3:40 pm

**Uniform Infraction Policy**

**If student is not in proper uniform (outside of mitigating circumstances):**

<b>First Offense</b>	Warning Loaner item given to student Incident logged in tracker
<b>Second Offense</b>	Phone call home Loaner item given to student Incident logged in tracker
<b>Third+ Offense</b>	Infraction Letter sent home Loaner item given to student Loss of next immediate privilege (i.e. next uniform free day, incentive, etc) Incident logged in tracker.

- **If a scholar is wearing something that can be taken off, give the student a warning and direct them to place the item in the locker.**
